Dr. Wolter's new book, *A United Nations for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: From Reaction to Prevention* takes a thorough look at the policies, movements and opportunities that offer hope for the development of what Wolter calls "an effective and efficient international regime for conflict prevention and peacebuilding."

Among the policies and activities for which he advocates, Wolter calls for a special UN summit in 2010 on 'conflict prevention and human security' to examine the tools, political strategies and funding resources needed to operationalize the 'responsibility to protect' and promote peace building on a global level.

Scheduled respondents include the Vice Chair of the Peacebuilding Commission, **H.E. Carmen Mariá Gallardo Hernández** of El Salvador and **Dr. Hussein Solomon**, director of the Centre for International Political Studies at the University of Pretoria, South Africa. The discussion will be chaired by **Dr. Neclâ Tschirgi**, Policy Advisor for the UN Peacebuilding Support Office.
